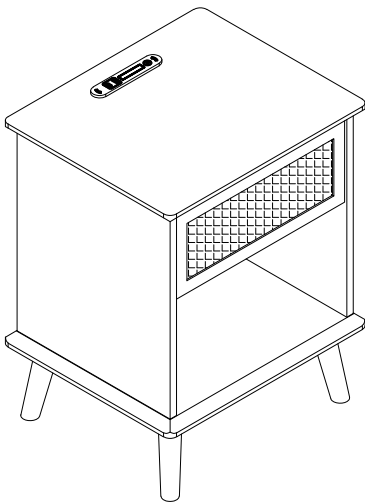


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

TEAGAN END TABLE







Please read below before assembly:

- Assemble the product on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish.
- Do not discard any content until assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Take out all parts and hardware from box.
- Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.

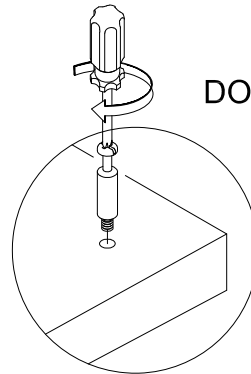

Using Camlocks

Step 1

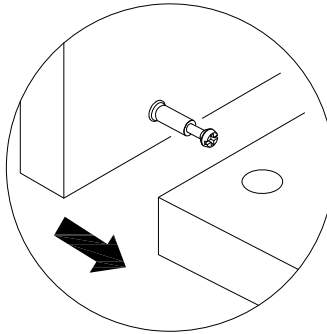
Connect the male camlock with a piece of board.



DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN.

Step 2

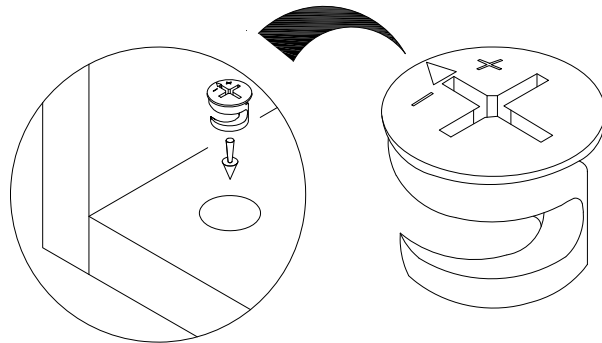
Insert the male camlock into the predrilled hole.



Step 3

Insert the female camlock.

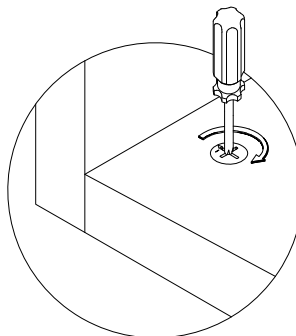
Note: Ensure that the arrow on the top of the camlock points towards the entry hole for the male camlock.
















Step 4

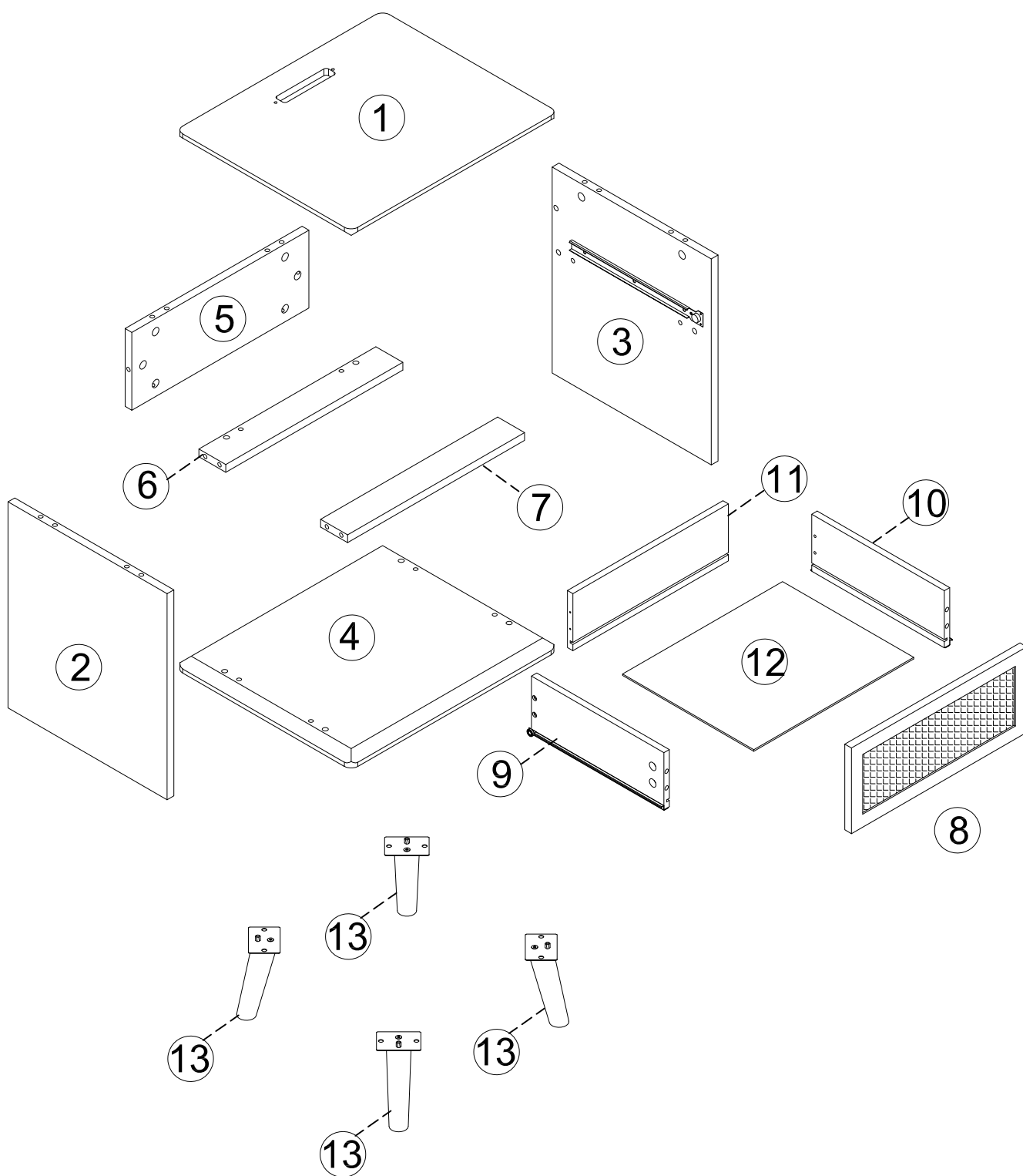
Turn the female camlock clockwise with a screwdriver.

You should feel a click when the camlock is locked in place, the joint is now secure.










Care & Maintenance

Do...



Wipe up spills immediately.



Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free, dry cloth.



Use mild non-abrasive soap and water.

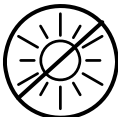
Don't...
